Proposed catchment change for Fareham Academy

Fareham Academy is proposing changes to its catchment area as part of a wider review of catchment areas in the area, following Hampshire County Council's decision to relocate Henry Cort Community College to the new site at North Whiteley from September 2027.

The current position:

Fareham Academy's currently has a catchment area which includes feeder schools Redlands Primary School, Wallisdean Junior School, Ranvilles Junior School, St Jude's Catholic Voluntary Aided Primary School, Titchfield Primary School & St Columba C of E Primary School.

The proposal:

To extend the catchment boundary for Fareham Academy so that it incorporates Titchfield Primary School and St Columba CE Primary School and their catchment areas (currently linked to The Henry Cort Community School in its existing location) and include these schools as feeder schools for Fareham Academy in criterion 7 in the admission policy (see also attached).

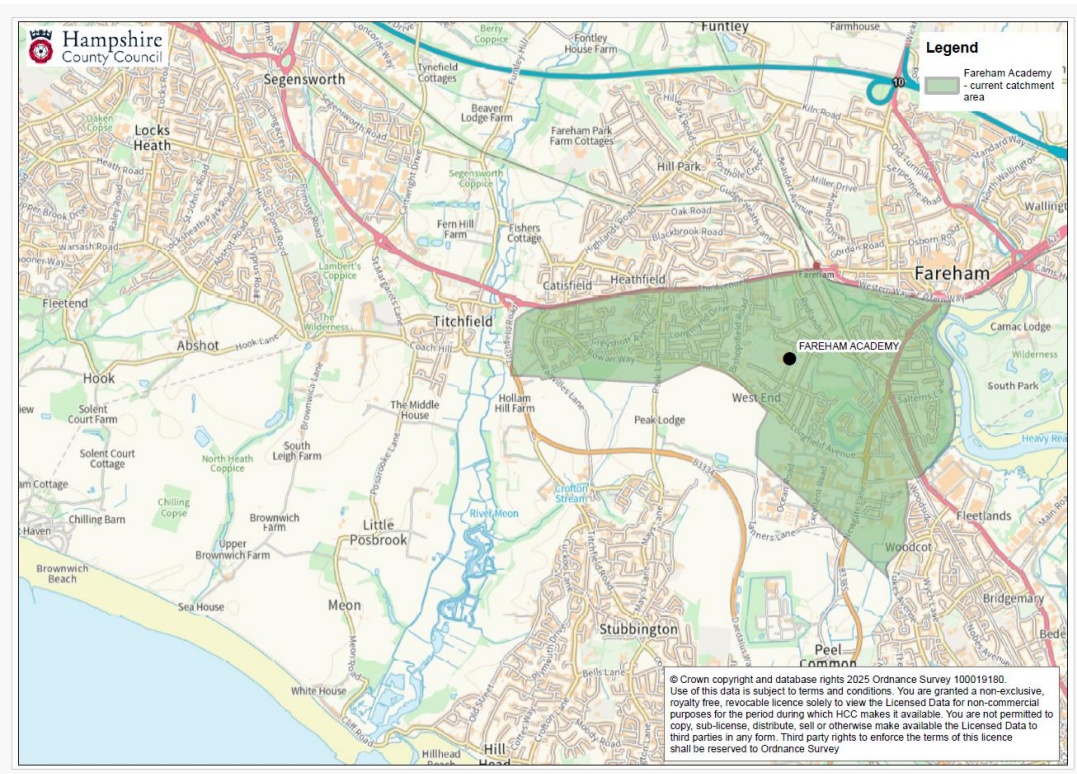
The catchment changes have been developed alongside the local authority and other Headteachers due to the relocation and proposed new catchment area of the Henry Cort Community College. This proposal ensures that these feeder schools have a linked secondary school.

Admission arrangements:

This proposal, changes the catchment boundary to include the following feeder schools Redlands Primary School, Wallisdean Junior School, Ranvilles Junior School, St Jude's Catholic Voluntary Aided Primary School, Titchfield Primary School & St Columba C of E Primary School. Our admission arrangements and oversubscription criteria remain unchanged other than the additional feeder schools.
