THE LINK CENTRE

Inclusion is an integral part of our ethos at Fareham Academy. We are especially proud of our Hearing Impaired Resource Provision, which is fully integrated into our wider school community.

Our state-of-the-art listening aids and specialist support enable students to access learning alongside their peers, while trained staff work one-to-one or in small groups under the guidance of our Teacher of the Deaf. This ensures that every student within the provision is able to maximise their potential and thrive both academically and personally.

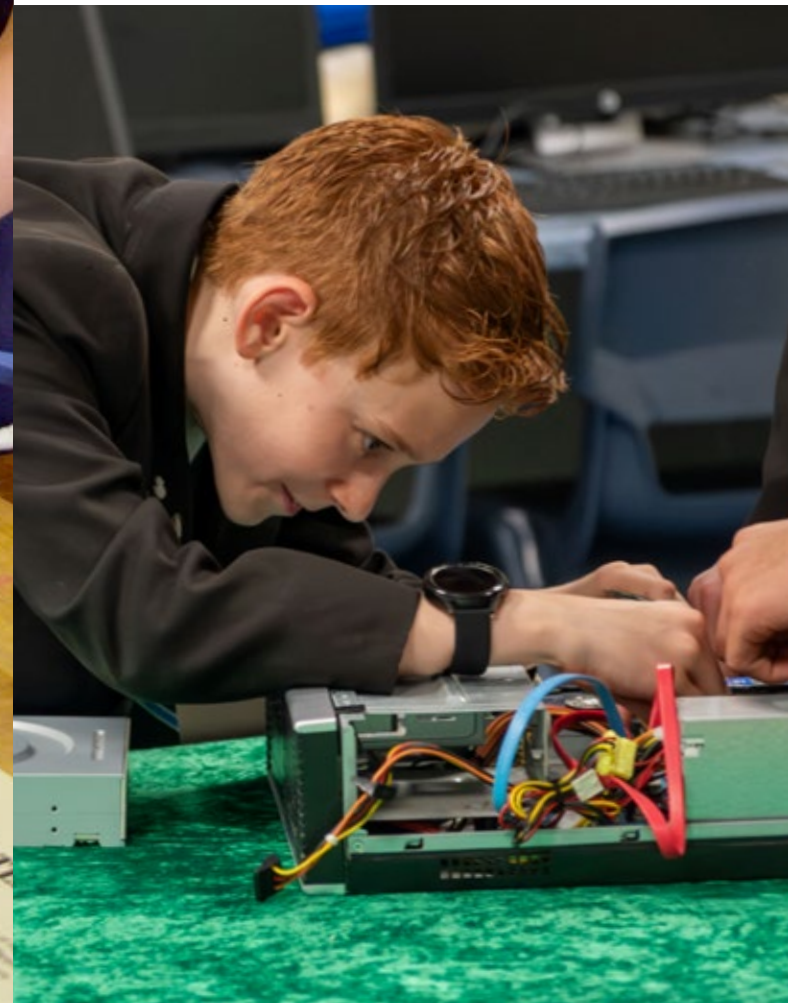

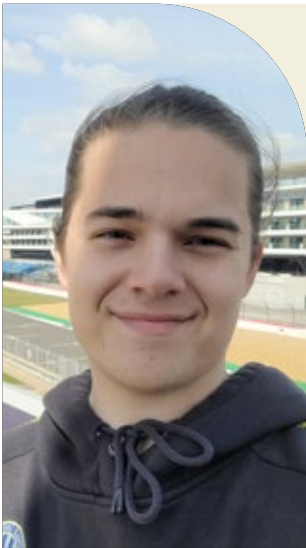
