Year 7 Aspirations RAK Day- 29th April

I am writing to give you a brief update of our upcoming RAK Day. Fareham Academy's Personal Development Learning education embraces the challenges of supporting young people to lead a happy and successful adult life through enabling them to make informed decisions about their wellbeing, health and relationships and future pathways. We aim to equip students to make confident decisions when facing risks, challenges, and complex situations. Our curriculum supports and prepares students for their responsibilities and experiences for adult life.

The themes the students will be exploring on the Aspirations RAK Day are:

STEM Bridge Building – Team Building activity. Students will be in competition as to who can create the best bridge applying their knowledge of STEM and ensure the bridge meets the necessary requirements.

Careers for Change – Students discover the skills and attributes needed for employment and enterprise and to consider how to effectively present and communicate ideas as part of a team. Students will work together to complete various tasks, aiming to improve student's teamwork and problem-solving skills.

Eco Club - This session is designed to get students thinking about the impact of their choices on the environment. Through making a personal pledge and taking part in a practical gardening activity, students will explore how conscious, positive actions can contribute to a more sustainable future.
