Plans for summer 2022 GCSE, AS and A level exams are expected to be confirmed early in the coming autumn term.

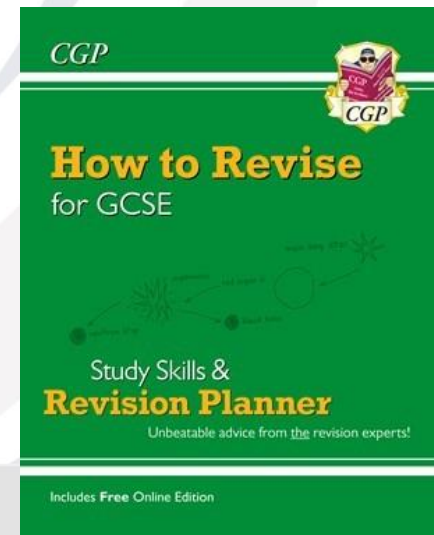
- Data driven teaching and learning to ensure lessons build on all students prior learning and allow them to achieve their potential

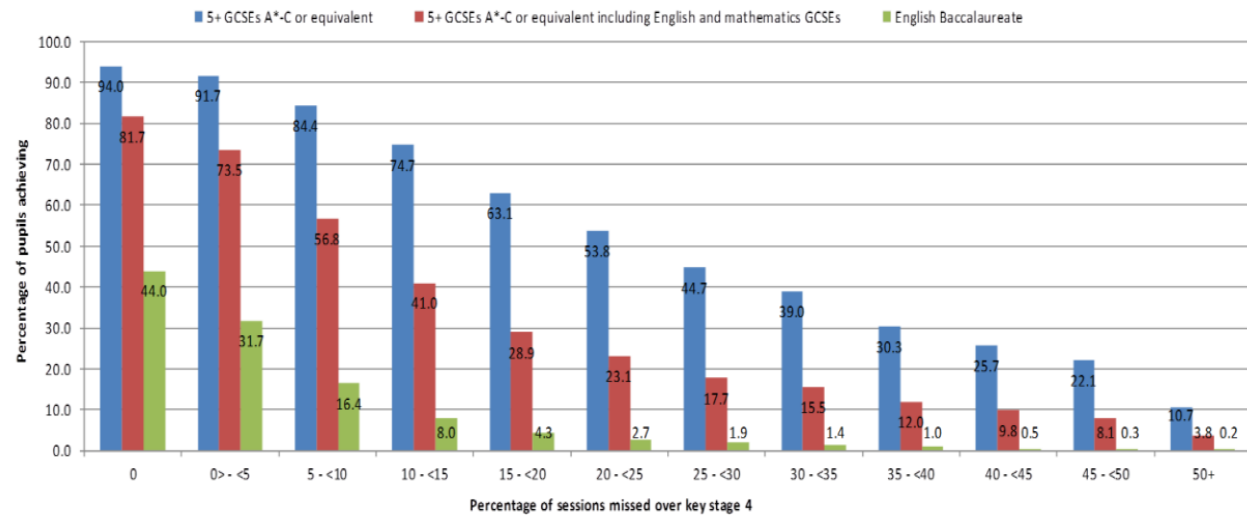
