

Summer School August 2021

Activities funded by DFE Summer School Grant

Schools were notified by the DfE of available funding to run a Summer school for students due to the impact of the pandemic on students learning, wellbeing and cultural capital.

Fareham Academy organised a programme for summer school ran over a 2-week timescale.

Week 1 was year 6 students transitioning into year 7. We worked with the Primary school of the students that had chosen Fareham Academy to find out those students who were low income and/or vulnerable, SEND or a singular student from a Primary out of catchment. We sent out 85 invites to the week. We had 40 students reply and the costing for that are outlined below.

The student activities that were chosen focussed on team building, wellbeing, enrichment and inclusivity (please see summer programme below).

The programme above was run by school staff with Military Mentors running an all-day session.

Year 6 Transition days:

A 2-day transition programme was organised as were unable to run transition during term time due to COVID. We thought it this was the right direction to take so that we could endeavour to provide a sense of the pastoral nature of Fareham Academy.

137 students attend on the Monday and Tuesday.

Monday's programme consisted of Maths, Art, Performing Arts and Modern Foreign Language lessons as well as meeting in their Tutor Classrooms. We ran Dance, Karate and Gardening workshops in the afternoon, as well as having an ice cream van turn up. On the Tuesday we ran team building session's run by Military Mentors, Boogie bounce, gardening, American Football and music and drama. We also had the ice cream van come in. These two days were also staffed with school staff.

Year 9 /10 study week

The English & Maths Department provided the names of Year 9 and 10 students to receive relevant intervention from High Impact Learning. The year 10 sessions were an introduction to GCSE studies.

Refreshments were provided and some days the ice cream van was available.
