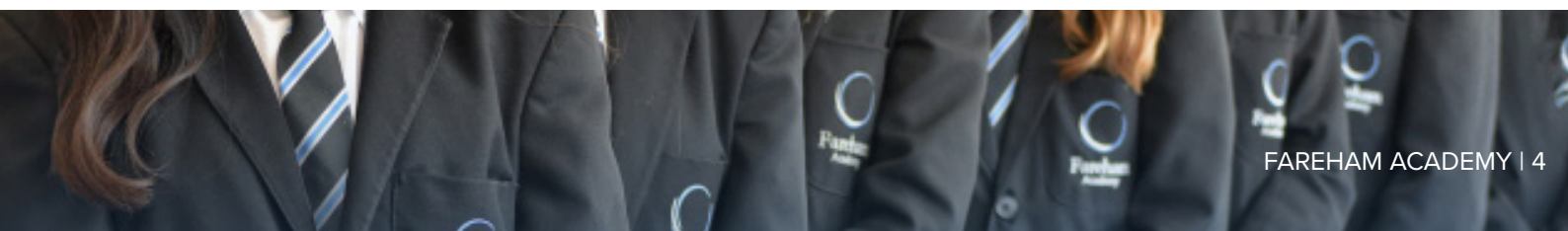

UNIFORM



Branded Blazer

Black school blazer.



Shirt

Plain white shirts (long or short sleeve) with the school tie.



Socks

Grey, black, or white socks.



Branded Summer Polo Top

This top can be worn during the summer term only and is intended to replace the regular shirt, jumper, tie, and blazer during hot weather.



Branded Jumper

Black V-neck jumper with blue inlay (optional).



Trousers

Black trousers.
(No cord, denim, or leggings.)



Shoes

Plain black leather or patent leather shoes.

(Boots, dolly shoes, sports trainers, and canvas shoes are not permitted.)

Hair

Hairstyles must not be extreme or outrageous, and unnatural colours and shaved heads are not permitted.

You may be sent home if you arrive at school with a haircut too close to the scalp.

Makeup

Year 11 students may wear discreet makeup and clear or natural-coloured nail varnish.

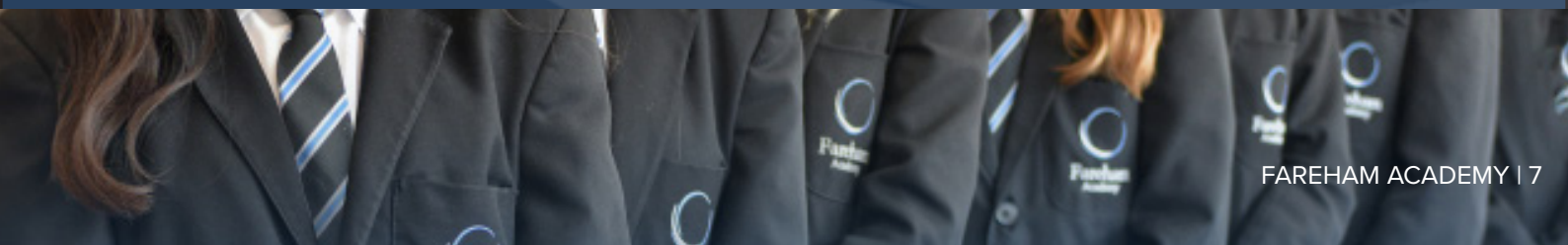
Students in all other years are not permitted to wear makeup or nail varnish.

Jewellery

Jewellery is not suitable for school due to safety and security concerns, therefore students are only permitted to wear:

- a watch
- a single chain with a religious symbol (hidden from view)
- single studs in the ear lobe.
