Re: Parking & Safety

The Academy works closely with our community to ensure that issues that may affect our local residents are discussed and resolved to a mutually beneficial level. If there are no available car parking spaces, please park outside the school grounds ensuring you do not block residents' driveways and walk into school to collect your child(ren).
